



SCHOOL TOUR



One of Legacy's primary outreach initiatives is our Annual School Tour. This program is led by young people across the United States, and around the world, who are trained as speakers to educate students about important social issues and empower them to take action. These School Tour Ambassadors deliver in-person and virtual, peer-to-peer presentations that are highenergy and multimedia rich. The goal of this program is not only to educate students about important issues, but to move them to solve those issues by joining our free leadership and mentorship programs which help them develop the skills they need to change the world.







STUDENT LEADERSHIP PROGRAM



Our Student Leadership program is the driving force behind our activation and development of student leaders. Once a student commits to joining our Leadership Program, each student participates in a journey that grows and develops them as an individual, with the goal to develop the skills they need to create real, tangible change in the world today. The Leadership Program is time-sensitive, cohortbased, part pre-recorded digital/part virtual live-sessions led by mentors, and runs on a rolling basis throughout the academic year. The program is made up of four modules that build the skills of Self and Social Awareness, Goal Setting, Strategic Planning, Marketing, Communication, and Fundraising. Every student is matched with a mentor that guides them through the program that includes video content, worksheets, live lessons, and action steps. The purpose of the program is to guide and shape the leadership development of a student so that they can use their time, money, voice, or vote to impact the world today!

STUDENT SPEAKER PROGRAM



In order to be a student leader, it is imperative for young people develop communicators as effectively spread a message. The Speaker Program challenges students to step outside of their comfort zone a communicator, grow as specifically for the purpose organizing a movement of supporters their school and in their at community. The Speaker Program is time-sensitive, mentorship intensive experience that includes pre-recorded videos and virtual live-sessions led by mentors. The program is built around three modules, where students learn about the power of storytelling, the of written and oral value communication, and how to structure and deliver a presentation. Led by a Legacy mentor, our Speaker Program challenges young people to leverage their voice to change the world.

SCHOOL CLUB PROGRAM



Legacy helps student leaders to be active participants in solving global issues like the global water crisis, climate change, and gender equality. Legacy also currently powers one of its partner organizations, The Thirst Project's, work in the field to help END the global water crisis. For students who want to go deep, who don't just want to lead a fundraiser or awareness campaign for a cause, but who want to start their own miniature "organizations", Legacy offers our School Clubs Program. When students want to organize groups of peers to collectively take action around the water crisis, Legacy mentors and develops students to take action by creating a "Thirst Project Club" at their school. Legacy's Thirst Project Club Program provides monthly mentorship students, guiding each leader on the steps that need to be taken to effectively start, manage, and lead a club. This mentorship includes training on both soft skills, hard skills, and skills specific to a student who creates or leads a club.






LEGACY SUMMIT


